Abstract:-

This paper gives the information and trends in use of smartphone and internet among girl students. Nowadays, the smartphone and internet use is most popular in students. The internet service is very demanded. The telecommunication market is fast growing. So it is keen interest to access the students for the use of mobile and it's services, necessity, negative effects of mobile, reluctant feeling, uncomforting feeling, mindlessly checking, internet for online education, intense urge, money spend and time spend with mobile use. For this, the sample of 75 girl students from all three classes of science graduation offering physics subject in Malegaon, state Maharashtra.
