The IQAC cell has been facilitating at the college level to maintain and the policy of quality education. The cell consists of representatives of varied fields. The cell regularly holds meetings with its members to plan and discuss initiatives for promotion of quality to cater the needs of the students. IQAC conducts the meeting of Academic Calendar Committee and chalks out the academic planning. It also keeps a check on effective implementation of policy decisions and regularly takes a review of the process. It forms various committees for effective implementation of curricular, cocurricular and extracurricular activities.

IQAC in collaboration with all departments of the college organized National and International webinars throughout the year. It chose the most innovative topics for the Webinars and invited resource persons across India. IQAC and Department of Zoology jointly organized a seminar on Human Health and Entrepreneurship on 10.01.2023. Mr. Sagar Zalte was the resource person of the seminar. IQAC organized a seminar on Academic and administrative audit (AAA) by Dr. Arif Anjum of City college Malegaon on 19.01.2023. IQAC organized AAA Orientation Program on 01.02.2023. The resource person of this programme was Prin. Dr. B.S. Jagdale (Prin. LVH College Nashik). On 09.03.2023, IQAC organized the one day workshop on “Revised NAAC Re-accreditation Process” at KBH law college Hall. Dr. B.S.Jagdale Trustee, Mahatma Gandhi Vidyamandir's and Principal, Loknete Vyankatrao Hiray, guided the participants about new education policy and its implementation with the help of PPT presentation. The Internal Quality Assurance Cell makes deliberate efforts for quality enhancement. Research Centre for the subject Marathi sanctioned by Savitribai Phule Pune University, Pune. The institute has conducted a Skill Development Course on 'Business Correspondence and Business Facilitator' and 'Account Executive' sanctioned by Dindyal Antyoday Yojana-

National Urban Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NULM) and Maharashtra State Skill Development Society. NCC branch proposal is sanctioned and further process is awaited. Student centric approach, experiential and participative learning through projects, field visits, internship, training and employability enhancement programmes are organized. Teachers maintain course file that contains academic calendar, syllabus, teaching plan, time table, COs, POs, attendance, question paper, mark list, course completion reports and outcome attainments. MOU's and collaboration with various institution and agencies by various departments. Received Books of Rs. 2 lakh for the library donated by Shri. Siddhivinayak Ganapati Mandir Trust. Skill oriented Add on and Value added certificate courses for the students are organised by Dept. of Zoology, Chemistry and Commerce. Students and teachers participated in 'Avishkar' Research Project competition. 11 projects from the students presented at Zonal Level. Students participated in INNOFEST research competition and received three prizes in Humanities and Science and Technology. Submitted research proposal to BOD, SPPU in subjects Chemistry, Botany and Zoology. 06 staff and 114 students enrolled for NPTEL courses. Staff Academy for faculty organised various lectures and five days FDP on "NEP initiatives for NAAC reaccreditation". Eye check-up camp for students and their mothers in collaboration with Rotary Club was organised on 12.10.2022. IQAC, EDP, ICC, NSS, SDO and various committees organised various programmes for overall development of the students. One student selected for Soft Ball interuniversity competition held at Chandigarh University and one student for National Yoga competition held at Jaipur. Faculty published research papers in National, International UGC care and peer reviewed research journals. Management initiated Teacher Awards under "Developing and Distinguished" category to motivate the Teachers for improving their performance. One faculty received award under "Distinguished" category.

Besides, IQAC has submitted AQAR for the academic year 2021-22 on NAAC portal on 27<sup>th</sup> March 2023 and submitted IIQA on 31<sup>st</sup> March 2023. SSR for the assessment year 2017-18 to 2021-22 has been submitted by the IQAC on 05<sup>th</sup> July 2023. The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) headed by Dr. Deepanjali K. Borse chalks out a plan of action for an academic year. The planning is discussed and reviewed in its meeting. The cell keeps a check on timely implementation of the plan of action. Regular meetings of IQAC chaired by the CDC Chairman Hon. Dr. Sampada Hiray are conducted.
