Annual Report

On the occasion of "National Doctor's Day,one-day webinar titled "COVID-19 and Vaccination Awareness" was organized by the Women's Welfare and Grievance Redressal Committee of Mahatma Gandhi Vidyamandir's Smt. Pushpatai Hiray Mahila Mahavidyalaya on 1st July 2021. The webinar was held under the guidance of the esteemed Chairperson of the Women's Welfare and Grievance Redressal Committee, Honorable Smt. Sampada Hiay.

The renowned expert, Dr. Anuradha Shewale from Ajanta Fertility Center in Aurangabad, provided guidance during the program. Building immunity in the body is crucial, especially during the COVID-19 pandemic. She emphasized the importance of including protein-rich and waterabundant diets to strengthen the body's immune response and minimize the impact of external viruses.

The second speaker for this virtual event was Dr. Rahul Bharad, a pediatrician from Sanjeevani Hospital in Aurangabad. He explained the significance of vaccination in detail and also provided comprehensive information about various institutions offering vaccination services. He highlighted the need for a well-designed vaccination schedule for infants, children, and pregnant women.



positive response and expressed their positive feedback.




Report on Yoga for "Aatmnirbhar Bharat"









Report on Workshop on Protection of Women's Rights and Prevention of Sexual Harassment in Educational Institutions (12/07/2017)

A workshop on "Protection of Women's Rights and Prevention of Sexual Harassment (Prohibition and Redressal) Act 2013" was conducted jointly by Smt. Pushpatai Hiray Arts, Science and Commerce Mahila Mahavidyalya Malegaon Camp workshop was organized under the auspices of the College's Women's Grievance Redressal Committee.

The workshop aimed to raise awareness about the objectives and activities of the Women's Grievance Redressal Committee in the college.
